Pieced Lily pattern. ---- Ooops sorry didn't realize this was only 10" finish. I looked at the pattern and figured to make it to a 12" you'd need to adjust the pattern as follows:

Keep the center sashings to a 2.5" finish so cut these_ Patch C 2.5 x 5.5 Patch A square in center cut 2.5 inch square.

Then make the 4 lily patches to finish at 5" as follows:

Patch A cut 3" square x 4 in background Patch B cut 3.75" squares 2 of each of background and colour. Then cut across diagonal twice for quarter-square triangles - you'll have 16 in total.

Patch D cut 2 squares 5 +7/8ths inches. Before cutting diagonally follow instructions (below) for adding the triangles first then cut diagonally. (hope that makes sense) For the triangle patches(at the bottom of Patch D) I'd cut 3" squares and follow instructions as in McCalls pattern.

Then proceed to put the block together as per McCalls diagrams.
